Limits of Local Standards	Leases	January 2013

PURPOSE:

The Service Manager may set local standards regarding leases in addition to provincial requirements.

HOUSING SERVICES ACT:

The following are prescribed, for the purposes of subsection 75 (2) of the Act, as matters with respect to which a Service Manager may make local standards:

5. Leases for units in Part VII housing projects (367/11 s. 100).

POLICY:

The Service Manager requires Rent-Geared-to-Income leases to adhere to the following criteria:

- 1. The term of the lease can be annual or by month.
- 2. The term of the lease is not to exceed one (1) year.
- 3. The lease must restrict occupancy of unit.
- 4. The lease must prohibit subletting or assignment of the lease.
- 5. The lease shall set out required signatories to the lease.
- 6. The lease shall refer to the market rent cost of the unit.
- 7. The lease shall set out the amount of initial Rent-Geared-to-Income assistance.
- 8. The lease shall set out that Rent-Geared-to-Income assistance is subject to change.
